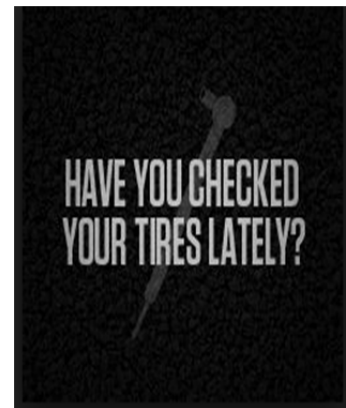
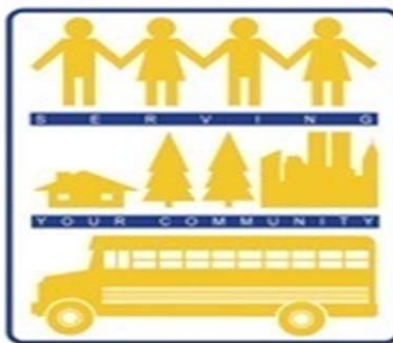


Safety is No Accident

IMPORTANT TIPS FOR DRIVING A SCHOOL BUS IN WINTER WEATHER

- Adjust your speed to conditions
- Keep the windshield clear of snow, ice and fog
- Follow at a safe distance
- Gently apply your brakes to slow down or stop
- Get the "feel" of the road
- Do not use cruise control where roads might be slick
- Take your time, arrive safely
- Ensure your lights are clean and visible to other vehicles
- Dress warm in layers so you are prepared to do your pre-trip, but also have the ability to be comfortable when driving.

The daily route or charter sheet for example gives us not only your hours worked for the day, but also documents your Hours Of Service, ridership records, and mileage recording.

Documentation of incidents and accidents not only records events while they are fresh in your mind, but also documents those involved, critical details and those whom you may have discussed the information with.

The DVIR protects the driver by documenting the vehicle checks and in the event of an accident can protect a driver who follows the procedures and gets sign offs before they drive vehicles with a previous defect and turn in defects in a timely manner.
